Guidelines for **Paper Submission**





Guidelines for Paper Submission

All Conference participants are invited to present a paper on a topic of your choice related to one of the following sub-themes:

Sub-themes

- Professional Relevance and Quality of Higher Education: Collaboration and Integration with Industry
- Innovation and Quality in Higher Education Curriculum and Pedagogy in line with Industry Collaborations
- Fostering Quality of Flexible Learning Pathways
- Driving for Excellence in Higher Education: Role of External Quality Assurance

Each proposal should include the following:

- (1) A Paper of no more than 3000 words in length, including the appendices, tables, illustrations,
- (2) and photographs;An abstract of around 200 words;
- (3) A bio-sketch of up to 100 words;
- (4) One photo of the author main author in JPEG format (Acceptable dimension: minimum 960W x 1080H).

Your proposal and photo should be submitted via the Portal below. Your proposal should include (1)-(3) in one document in Word (.docx) or PDF (.pdf) format.

Each file should be labelled according to the below formats:

Proposal

Name your proposal with the sub-theme number and main author's full name: "(i)_John-LEWIS" (this means it is a proposal under sub-theme (i) and is submitted by John LEWIS (all capitals for last name))

Photo

"Photo_John-LEWIS"

Papers will be reviewed by a review committee. The acceptance of papers for inclusion in the Programme is at the prerogative of the review committee.

If the paper is selected, you will have:

- 15 minutes for presentation;
- 10-15 minutes for questions/discussion at the end of the session.

All submissions must be in *English*.

Upon receipt of your confirmation, we will remove your original submission within three working days and notify you when you may resubmit via the online portal. Only the **final version** of the submission will be kept in the portal.
